Thank you for your desire to help our families feel at home during their time with us. Welcome Bags are lovingly placed in each guest room when families check in to make their stay more comfortable.

How can your group go about making these welcome bags?

Your group is responsible for the bags or totes themselves and filling with new items.

Once the meal kits are made, they should be dropped off at RMHC Charleston. You can deliver the bags between 8:00am-8:00pm. The staff and volunteers at the House will then distribute the bags to the 32 families staying at the House.

Your group is also encouraged to write inspiration quotes and to include small activities. Because many families have different beliefs, we ask that you or your group refrain from religious messages. It is, however, acceptable to include a message saying, "We'll keep you in our thoughts."

Below are some examples of items that would be appropriate to include in the bags:

- Blanket
- Stuffed animal
- Deck of cards/card games (Uno, Old Maid, etc.)
- Journal
- Activity books
- Puzzle books (Sudoku, crossword, etc.)
- Pencils/pens
- Hand sanitizer
- Lotion
- Books for adults or children
- Tissues
- Chapstick
- Reusable water bottles
- Full-sized toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, etc.)
- Individual snacks
